Due to the complicated nature of the Rabbit gastro-intestinal system it is <u>very</u> important to ensure that every animal that has had a General anaesthetic starts eating and drinking as soon as possible. It is also important that they are passing faeces freely to ensure gastric movement is correct. For this reason we may have kept your rabbit in the hospital overnight. If your rabbit is not passing faeces or eating at home please contact the practice as soon as possible.
